Before the exam



Register for the [UK English Exam](http://uk.cambridgeenglish.org) using your Candidate ID and Candidate Reference Number from your Confirmation of Entry.

Check the date, time and address of your exam. Your centre will send you the information.

Check with your centre if there is food or drink available at the exam or nearby. You may need to bring your own refreshments.

Find out how to get to the centre and where you will sit. Follow the short lines at the centre. Follow the directions to the exam room or sat at reception.

You cannot bring your mobile phone or electronic items into the exam room.

Your centre will tell you if you can store your electronic items nearby. If they can't you should consider leaving your electronic items at home.

Please have any questions about your centre before the exam day.

What to bring to the exam



Bring your identification (ID). For example a passport or national ID card. It must be the original document with your photo and it must be valid on the day of your exam.

Bring your identification photo.

Bring ID and documents. Your centre will give you information and provide if you need them.

Do not bring food or drink to your desk in the exam room. Bring food in clear plastic bottles or tins.

You cannot have your personal belongings at your desk or bring your mobile phone or electronic items into the exam room.

Please check with your centre whether you need to bring ID and documents. You may need to bring your photo for identification when you enter.
